Thanksgiving Sunday

"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." 2 Corinthians 9:7

These words were spoken and celebrated at our annual Thanksgiving Service on 25th June 2017. We met together at Pacific Lutheran College for worship, friendship, food and fun. 112 people gathered to celebrate the Baptism of Ella Nixon, to hear God's Word, to receive Holy Communion and to be sent out with His blessing. Members and friends donated food items to share with the community who come to Happy Valley on Thursday nights.

Our Thanksgiving Offering was over \$6,000. We shared food and enjoyed our friendships.

Pastor Tim and Dr Dolling highlighted our ministry and mission with the College. They are working with Pastor Ray to create an agreed statement of common mission. "Grow and Share" monthly services have included: Blessings of Pets, 1st Communion on Maundy Thursday, Kindy blessing, Preps Bible presentations, Year 5 visits for Holy Communion service.

Dr Dolling thanked us for our prayer support and offered the opportunity to serve with the College at the newly established breakfast program with the Salvos at Kawana and the continued Cambodia mission work. Members are welcome to come to the Prep Classes and read a Bible story.

Tracie our treasurer presented our draft budget 2017/18 and encouraged the use of Regular Electronic Giving (R.E.G.).

Pastor Ray drew our attention to the recent National Church Life Survey results for St Marks and the encouraging responses for what we want to focus our attention on for the next twelve months:





Treasurer's Report Tracie Bucknall

Firstly, I would like yet again to thank Rollie Bruggemann, Alan Kruger and Rudi Maiwald for their help with collections and banking. This is a task that enables me to have held the treasurer role.

I would not have been able to

otherwise.

Continued thanks also to the M&V team who are a very considerate and supportive team and also the St Marks congregation members (8.00am and 9.30am) for supporting me in this role.

The current financial positon of the manse loan is available.

The budget for 2017/2018 has been drafted and I present for your initial review. Amendments may be made if required and put forward at our Annual AGM for acceptance.

You will note that the budget has a slight decrease for the second year in a row.

The budget for 2017 looks unlikely to be reached and so we will need to endeavour to reach budget in 2018 to prevent the further diminishment of our LLL savings account.

During 2017 we have endeavoured to keep costs below budget to minimise the shortfall impact. I again encourage you to consider regular giving as an option. It is a confidential way to make offerings and is also an easy option requiring no further action unless you wish to change the amount of your offering. We also have a regular Direct Debit set up for Manse Pledge which gives the same benefits.
