#### Confession:

C: I confess to you that I have done wrong in thoughts, words, and actions. I have been faint-hearted when I should have been strong. I have trusted my own power when I needed your power most. I have used time and money as if they were mine, wasting energy on unimportant things. I have given those closest to me less love and attention than I've given myself. I have been unloving, and superior, and impatient. I have taken your constant care for granted. Hear me, Lord, in your incredible mercy.

# Forgiveness:

P: Upon your confession, I, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God to all of you. On behalf of my Lord Jesus Christ and by his command, I forgive you all your sins, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. May he comfort you with his holy absolution, and strengthen you with his Sacrament, that your joy may be full. Peace be with you.

C: And also with you.

### Psalm 82

P: God brings his courtroom to order. This is his judgment on those who sit in judgment over others:

C: For too long you have perverted justice, you have let the wicked get away with murder.

P: Your task is to defend the vulnerable and helpless, and to stand up for the defenseless and the ill-treated.

C: Your task is to come to the aid of victims, and to protect them from abuse and exploitation.

P: But you know nothing, you understand nothing. You haven't the faintest idea about what's going on.

C: You are allowing civilization to fall to pieces around you.

P: I appointed all of you as judges, to act in my place, to be my representatives.

C: But you will end your life in dishonour, stripped of all privileges, your reputation shattered.

P: Rise up, God, take your place as judge of the whole earth.

C: Because all people, all the nations, belong to you.

First Reading: Jeremiah 23:23-29 - *The word of the living God is active*Am I a God near by, says the Lord, and not a God far off? Who can hide in secret places so that I cannot see them? says the Lord. Do I not fill heaven and earth? says the Lord. I have heard what the prophets have said who prophesy lies in my name, saying, "I have dreamed! I have dreamed!" How long? Will the hearts of the prophets ever turn back—those who prophesy lies and who prophesy the deceit of their own heart? They plan to make my people forget my name by their dreams that they tell one another, just as their ancestors forgot my name for Baal. Let the prophet who has a dream tell the dream, but let the one who has my word speak my word faithfully. What has straw in common with wheat? says the Lord. Is not my word like fire, says the Lord, and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces? This is the Word of the Lord.

#### C: Thanks be to God.

Gospel: Luke 12:49-56 - Jesus the cause of division

"I have come to cast fire upon the earth, and how I wish it were already ablaze! I have a baptism with which to be baptized, and what constraint I am under until it is completed! Do you think that I have come to bring peace to the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division! From now on five in one household will be divided, three against two and two against three; they will be divided: father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law." He also said to the crowds, "When you see a cloud rising in the west, you immediately say, 'It is going to rain,' and so it happens. And when you see the south wind blowing, you say, 'There will be scorching heat,' and it happens. You hypocrites! You know how to interpret the appearance of earth and sky, but why do you not know how to interpret the present time? This is the Gospel of the Lord.

C: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!

The Apostles' Creed

C: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.
And in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the
Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead,
and buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead.
He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty, from
thence he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the
holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the
resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Give healing to those who are not well at this time. Support and strengthen those we know with special needs and whom we now name silently in our hearts... (brief silence) Lord, in your mercy: hear our prayer.

C: Father in heaven, you have surrounded us with a great cloud of witnesses in the saints who have gone before us. Help us to follow their example of faith, always praying to you for all our needs, because you have promised to hear us in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

# SAFE PLACE & CHILD SAFE

LOVE COMES TO LIFE when we treat each other with courtesy and respect, and when the way we behave towards each other reflects the way God loves us.



# In our personal behaviour we demonstrate God's love by:

- setting a good example of Christian living
- treating each other with dignity and respect
- being courteous, kind and compassionate in our words and actions
- not abusing people (including members of our family), verbally, physically, emotionally, sexually or spiritually
- acting responsibly in potentially addictive activities which may cause harm to our family, such as abuse of alcohol, addictive substances or gambling
- refraining from engaging in, viewing or possessing pornographic materials; and
- cultivating a lifestyle of reconciliation.

# In caring for children we demonstrate God's love by:

- ensuring children feel safe, are respected and listened to
- considering the needs of children in all decisions regarding church activities
- not abusing children physically, emotionally sexually or spiritually
- ensuring that no form of physical punishment is administered to any child while engaged in church activities
- ensuring that systems for the prevention of harm to children are maintained; and
- ensuring compliance with all legislative requirements for the health, safety and wellbeing of children.

The LCA Safe Place Committee has established a confidential service for responding to complaints of sexual abuse/harassment by church employees and leaders. Trained advisors are available to help.
